

Oracle Implementation for a Crown Corporation

Case study



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Scope

- Replace its multiple back-office systems with a modern ERP system.
- Have a seamless payment processing as it is critical part of the business process.
- Procurement process was required to be streamlined with the scope of eliminating manual process and digitizing any paperwork.
- Advance and centralize data analytics capabilities.
- Eliminate the manual planning and budgeting process and achieve a new integrated, sophisticated, and automated planning system.

Approach

- An integrated ERP solution consisting of eBusiness Suite for all the daily financial and procurement operation integrated with automated payments for suppliers and retailers was selected and implemented.
- Custom data warehouse for all the retailers and online transactional information integrated with Oracle GL was built to have the centralized data repository for all the analytics needs.
- OBIEE leveraged the data warehouse and provided reporting and analytics capability.
- Oracle Supplier Lifecycle Management (iSupplier) and Sourcing was implemented to help eliminate the manual paperwork.
- Integrated Enterprise Performance Management (Hyperion) for all the corporate planning and budgeting processes which significantly improved the accuracy and reduced effort.



Value delivered

1. The project resulted in the Corporation realizing its goal of establishing an enterprise-wide view of information across the business and managing its data as a corporate asset. A 'single source of truth' data warehouse enabled consistent and verifiable data reporting across the organization. The following benefits were also achieved:
2. Increased business efficiency through business process automation, workflow, and integration.
3. Scalable growth providing the Corporation with functionality to manage a growing and complex business operations.
4. A single ERP provided coherent business information (BI).
5. The BI tools enabled the Corporation's employees and leadership to make better, faster, data-driven decisions.
